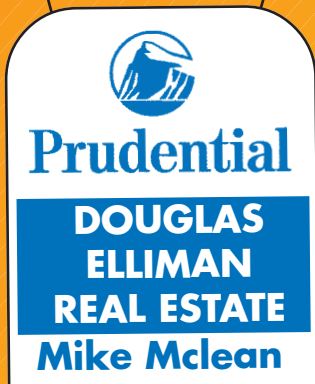


In Justice & Healing

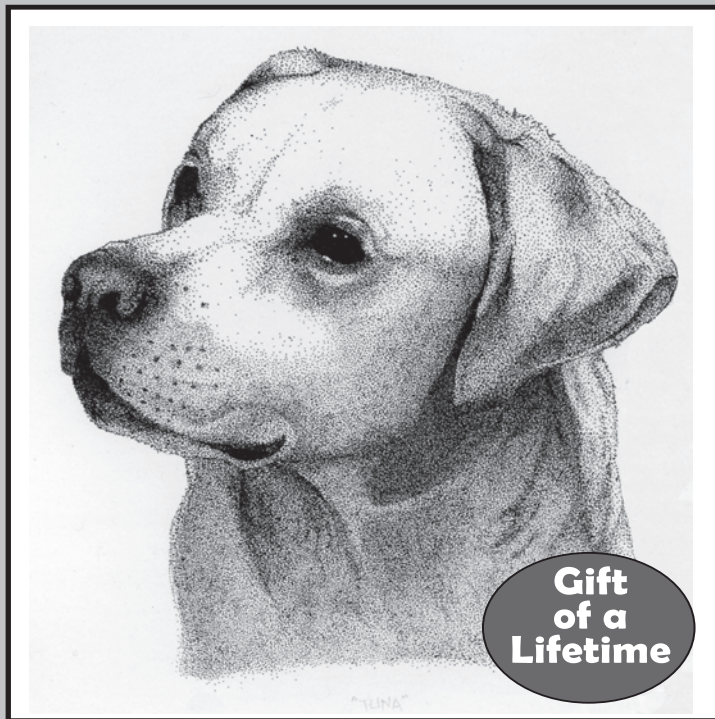

Perhaps it is time to wake up.

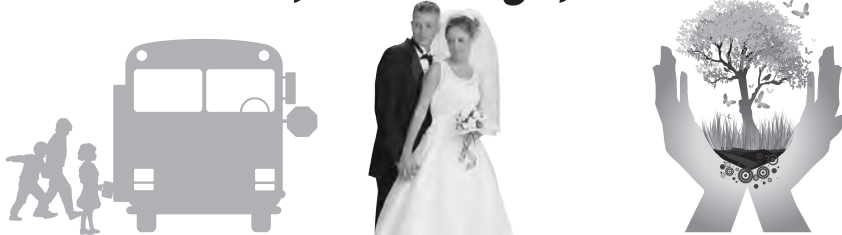

risk" Long Island teen.

Ruvolo and Goldman's presentation about the at risk youth population gave insight into the juvenile delinquency recidivism rate in local prisons and what attendees can do to decrease this number through various programs and initiatives.

The duo also work together with the TASTE program; a program which helps to create accountability and spur conflict resolution in an effort to end violence and restore safety in local schools.

Shredding Success



Teachers Federal Credit Union (TFCU), one of the country's largest credit unions, held a Shredding Day at its Hauppauge headquarters. The free e-waste recycling/destruction and paper shredding day

brought community and TFCU members out in droves.

Families and individuals took advantage of the opportunity to get rid of tons of accumulated paper documents and electronic waste (e-waste) for secure

destruction and recycling. Many people stayed to watch the paper shredding, which was done on-site by Cintas Document Management.

The electronic materials, including obsolete computers, old

hard drives, monitors, printers, cell phones, scanners and radios, were placed in containers for off-site secure destruction by e-Scrap Destruction. This year, 550 cars came down to the branch to participate, with a total of 16,020 pounds of paper and 12,744 pounds of e-waste collected. In addition, United Way of Long Island collected 5,000 gently used books to help stuff two on-site vans. This effort will allow United Way to build its library of books that will be available for children and young adults across Long Island.

"This was our eleventh Shredding Day. Hundreds of TFCU members and local residents brought their paper documents and their outdated electronic equipment to

our Hauppauge headquarters to be destroyed in an environmentally safe and secure manner. In addition, the response to the call for books in support of United Way's library was very impressive. TFCU's Shredding Day program was originally planned to help reduce identity theft and fraud but has evolved into an environmental and a consumer awareness program that reflects TFCU's commitment to our members and to all Long Islanders," said Robert G. Allen, TFCU President/CEO.

Shredding personal documents and properly destroying computer hard drives and other electronics reduces the possibility of identity theft

and the potential for fraud. e-Scrap Destruction collected these items at the site and was responsible for the complete and secure destruction of the materials at its modern Islandia facility.

Over the last few years, TFCU has sponsored eleven shredding days, collecting a total of 102,654 pounds of paper and 67,763 pounds of electronics. More than 3,000 members and local residents have participated in TFCU Shredding Days.

A new take on grilled steak

Grilling season has returned and steak lovers everywhere have once again started to enjoy grilled steak. This season, add some more flavor to your grill with the following recipe for "Flatiron Steak and Tomatoes With Anchovy Vinaigrette," courtesy of "The Niman Ranch Cookbook," (Ten Speed Press).

Flatiron Steak and Tomatoes With Anchovy Vinaigrette *Serves 4*

Prepare and light a charcoal grill for cooking.

Heat 2 tablespoons of the olive oil in a 6-inch skillet over low heat. Add the anchovies and break up with a wooden spoon. Cook for 1 to 2 minutes, until the anchovies become aromatic. Add the garlic and crushed red pepper and cook for about 2 minutes, or until the garlic is cooked through but not browned. Remove from the heat and stir in 2 tablespoons of the vinegar. Set aside.

When the grill is at its hottest (when the coals are red and glowing and too hot to hold your hand over the grill for more than a couple of seconds), season the steak on both sides with salt and pepper. Place the steak on the cooking grate directly over the coals and cook uncovered, turning once, for 4 to 5 minutes per side for medium rare; the timing will depend on the thickness of the steak. Transfer to a cutting board and let rest of 5 minutes.

Slice the tomatoes and arrange in the center of a serving platter. Drizzle with the remaining 1 tablespoon olive oil and the remaining 1 teaspoon vinegar. Season with salt and pepper. Slice the steak thinly across the grain and arrange over the tomatoes. Pour the anchovy vinaigrette over the top of the steak. Serve.

Dear Readers,

Here's a special treat, some training tips from my favorite trainer/behaviorist/dog whisperer Kurt Wolff ("Uncle Kurt," as he's affectionately known)...

"Understanding the use of a training collar and applying it properly is not punishment, but rather, training using "discipline with love." A training collar was invented because a brilliant person realized that a dog's neck is the center of control. A corrective jerk, rather than a choke application, is the professional way to apply a correction, when necessary. Understanding why a dog does what he does, and understanding how the training is perceived in his head, is the only way to train. A training collar, when used by a trainer who truly understands innate dog behavior, is in no way painful and is not perceived by the

dog as a punishment. Effective dog trainers use the collar only to correct, and then re-direct the dog into position."

"Uncle Kurt" has been helping me train my German Shepherd, *True*, who understandably has some bad habits (barking, circling people for attention) after he was locked in a small bathroom and suffered abuse for the first four years of his life. It was amazing to watch the soft-voiced gentleman connect with *True* from the first moment he walked into my home. Uncle Kurt pointed out that some of *True's* disruptive behavior can actually be traced to his wolf ancestry. He explained the reason for *True's* excited circling - Uncle Kurt calls it "greet to eat." I noticed a difference in *True* right after the first lesson. I felt we were more deeply connected and I noticed that *True* now looks into my eyes with new

understanding and happy expectation.

When it comes to dog trainers, I know what I want and what I don't want...no pronged collars cutting into my dog's neck, no choking, and certainly no breaking of his spirit. I want the training to come from love and understanding.

So, for all of you Readers who e-mailed asking me to recommend a trainer, here's Uncle Kurt's contact information. And Readers, FYI - while Uncle Kurt is putting *True* through his paces, he's also spending plenty of time teaching me to train *True* and be a better "pet parent."
